

**When booking with FishYourDream.com I agree to the following:**

- To use only one fishing rod per person at a time.
- To use the rod actively, ie. not to angle the hook and leave it in the water.
- Not to keep more than one fish per person and day, for consumption on Gotland.
- Not to keep any sea trout under 50 cm.
- Not to keep any salmon under 60 cm.
- To release any pike or perch caught between March 1 to May 31.
- To handle fish to be released carefully; to use wet hands, knotless nets etc. and to keep the fish in the water as much as possible.
- To kill fish that is to be kept immediately.
- To report all caught fish whether kept or released. (Report cards will be provided by FishYourDream.com.)
- Not to fish in the areas restricted between October 1 and December 31. (Maps with these areas marked out is provided by FishYourDream.com.)
- To show respect for people; fishermen and others.
- Not to disturb any animals, wild or domestic.
- Not to leave cigarette butts, fishing lines, used hooks or other trash, in the water or in any other outdoor environment.
- Not to make open fires, other than in designated fireplaces. Fires must be put out with water before leaving.
- To follow the rules and instructions given by the guides and/or other staff.
- To accept full responsibility for any damage caused to accommodations, vehicles, boats, fishing gear or other equipment, rented or borrowed, by the client and/or by any other person belonging to the same group.
